Obstetric practice with or without gynaecology

The management of pregnancy after 24 weeks gestation. If a General Practitioner carries out any planned deliveries then the intrapartum obstetric rate must be paid. A non-obstetric GP may look after a patient up to delivery, provided that the delivery itself takes place in a hospital under the care of an obstetrician or other suitably qualified person.
